Chief Patron Sampling of Delegate Maldonado's Consumer Protection Laws Passed

- <u>Protecting Kids Online</u>: Passed Virginia's first online child data privacy law.
- <u>Opioid Prescription Law</u>: Requires medical professionals to tell patient the drug is an opioid, that it is addictive & offer alternative treatment options.
- <u>Elder Fraud</u>: Protection against financial exploitation of elders & vulnerable adults & establishment of uniform fraud detection & mitigation guidelines for banks & credit unions in Virginia.
- <u>Surprise Auto Renewals</u>: Protection of individuals and small businesses from surprise subscription & contract auto renewals.*

(*On October 16, 2024, U.S. Federal Trade Commissioner, Rebecca Kelly Slaughter, called out our bill in a public statement noting "The comment record compiled in the rulemaking proceeding strongly supports the wisdom of federal and state legislators' carefully considering adopting such a law")

 <u>Housing</u>: Law requiring landlords to give 60 days prior written notice if rent amount will increase upon renewal.
